Introduction to Tracking Workshop

The workshop is an introduction to learning how train a dog to follow a ground scent trail in order to find an item placed along the trail. Not only is tracking fun for you and your dog, it is also one of the many dog sports in which you and your dog can compete and gain nationally recognised titles.

We are asking for expressions of interest from members who would like to take part in the workshop. Dogs and their handlers will work apart from other participants, so this workshop will be great for dogs that may have “challenges” with other dogs.

Places are limited so get in quickly.

There will be two levels of participants: handlers with their dogs and non-dog participants (“buddies”). Each “buddy” will be paired with a dog/handler team and will take part in all education activities of the workshop but without their dog.
